

WDAA Points Overview

WDAA calculates points using two different calculation methods.

Method 1 calculates points for WDAA Test Classes.

Each Test offered by WDAA has a Maximum Score:

Each entrant for a given test will be scored based upon their performance of the test, and an Attainment Percentage will be calculated for that entrant's performance.

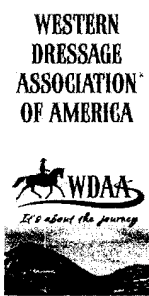

2013 WESTERN DRESSAGE TEST ~ BASIC LEVEL, TEST 2

Instructions: The horse should show carriage appropriate to this level. The nose should be carried out and level with the hip. The horse should be able to stretch its neck so the poll is as far forward (not down) as possible while still keeping the line of the canon of the hind leg matching the line of the forearm of the front leg. The rider is allowed to post at the jog. The contact should be light, but mindful of the fact that light contact with the rein has no relationship to the welfare of the horse if the back is compromised and the hindquarters are not properly engaged.

Example: An entrant in Basic Level Test 2 obtains a score of 289.5 on the test. The calculated Attainment Percentage is 289.5 / 360 or 80.4%

A Conversion Factor is applied to the Attainment Percentage for Basic Level Test 2 to obtain the Points Awarded for that test.

Example: An Attainment Percentage of 80.4% for a Basic Level Test is awarded 6 Points

Method 2 calculates points for WDAA Rail Classes.

Method 2 uses a traditional Judge Card for Calculating Points Awarded.

WDAA has three rail classes. They are Suitability, Hack and WD Equitation on the Rail. Points are awarded based on the number of entries in the class and the placing of each entrant in the class.

The following point system will be used to award points for these classes:
